



Dear team,

welcome to the 2019 J/70 European Championship in Malcesine. In this document you will find some useful information for logistics and organization.

1) Before your arrival

1.1 Inspection Agenda

From WEDNESDAY 29/05 you can choose your inspection slot through 2 DOODLE AGENDA, one for the boat and one for the sails. The deadline to choose your slot is **Friday 15 June**. Please consider that the doodle is only to express a preference, the Organizing Authority can change the measurement slot if necessary, in agreement with the team.

After choosing your preferred time for the inspection you have to fill in:

- 1) owner name
- 2) sail number
- 3) boat name.

These 3 data are requested in order to consider effective your preference.

Only one (1) time slot can be choosed, if more than one are selected all the preferences will be automatically deleted.

Remind that:

- Each boat should arrive in the area 1 hour before their scheduled time and have bow numbers applied (for crews participating in the J/70 CUP please hold your previously assigned bow number)
- The inspection will include your mast, required equipment, deck layout, fittings, hull weight, keel, rudder, sails and other items. You will be given instructions for how to proceed through several stations to complete the inspection. Upon your arrival in the area, you will be asked to attach your spreaders and shrouds to your mast (if not already attached), and carry your mast a short distance to the mast inspection area.
- The boat should arrive at the inspection with a minimum of 2 crew members.

- All required equipment, including a personal flotation device for each crew and VHF radio, will be required at inspection.

- SAILS INSPECTION AGENDA

Remind that:

- Sails should arrive in the area 15 min. before their scheduled time
- Sails should arrive at the inspection with a minimum of 2 crew members
- Not more than 1 mainsail, 1 headsail and 2 gennakers (1 as a spare) shall be presented for the event.
- Remove battens from sails
- Sail numbers shall correspond to the hull number molded into the transom of each boat
- Sails are required to be already certified by an official measurer and shall carry a Class Association Sail Royalty Label. If you need to measure the sails for the first time, please contact the J/70 Italian Class measurer (mbarbieri146@yahoo.com)

1.2 Online registrations

Your entry in Sailing Today must be already completed with:

- all the crew members
- World Sailing ID (only crew members with WS 1 classification are not required to register to the International Class)
- FIV card (only for Italian competitors)
- WS 1 classification for Corinthian team (all the crew).

Only if not already sent, Insurance certificate (minimum cover of 1.500.000,00€) and Manufacturer Declaration should be sent to info@j70.it.

In order to speed up the registration, consider that in the Race Office there will be two lines of which a "fast-track" for the crews with all the documents and entry in order.

2) At your arrival

2.1 Arrivals

On site and off site trailer storage is allowed starting from 20th June.
All the boats must be measured before being launched.

The arrival inside the Club must be the same day of the boat measurement. It is not allowed to stay at the club with the boat on the trailer. The only exception is for boats with a measurement slot in the morning: if you have a measurement slot before 11 am, you are allowed to arrive at the club on the afternoon before, after 15.00.

If a boat arrives before the measurement day the boat has to be stored in the trailer parking area and then move to the Club on the boat measurement day.

Boats stored at Fraglia Vela Malcesine between the J70 and the Europeans are exonerated by this regulations.

2.2 Boat and trailer number

A number will be assigned to each boat and trailer. This number is the mooring place and it coincides with the registration order.

A sticker with this number will be assigned and must be paste on the boat trailer.

Below you can find the entry list with the boat numbers.

2.3 Trailers

After the launching the trailer has to be moved to the trailer park, in Navene Vecchia street (see the map below). Only trailers from number 1 to number 50 are allowed to stay at the Club during the regatta. Boats trailers from number 51 to number 140 must be moved as soon as the boat as been launched to the trailer parking area in Navene Vecchia street (Coordinates: 45.771140, 10.816017), see map attached.



2.4 Moorings

Moorings are assigned following the registrations order (NOR point 3.3)

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places as directed by the OA when either afloat or ashore (NOR point 15.1).

2.5 Bow numbers

For crews participating to the J/70 CUP bow numbers are the same of the J/70 CUP and must be kept for the European Championship and the Italian Championship.

New boats will receive the bow numbers, together with all the class stickers and flags, at the moment of registrations.

3) Logistics for departures

Hauling out

The club intention is to haul out on Saturday 29th June 80 boats and the remaining boats on Sunday, 30th June.

Boats will be hauled out following the registration number.

At the Club two cranes are available, one at the South mooring and one at North mooring. Boats will be divided in odds and even numbers based on the boat and trailer number assigned (point 2.2). Boats with odd numbers are hauled out at the North mooring and boats with even number are hauled out at the South mooring.

The first 4 boats of the list can proceed directly to the hauling out areas, while all the other boats shall proceed back to their mooring places, and wait for staff to call them to proceed to the mooring. Please keep VHF well close to you. Once on the trailer, the van/car + trailer shall proceed immediately to the unrigging dedicated area.

When the first 40 boats have been hauled out, the next team (51-80) are allowed to move the trailers back to the club.

A dedicated space is reserved for unrigging at the Club, as soon as the boat is packed it must be moved away from the club. If the team is not leaving yet, the boat can be stored to the trailer parking area, until Sunday June 30th.
